



Connection to Soccer Complex

Newly built in 2017, The Bruce and Lee Foundation has partnered with the city of Florence to build a brand new, 14 field soccer complex. The complex will boast walking trails, ponds, lighted fields, restrooms, and a future picnic shelter.

Florence Rail Trail System will connect the soccer complex, via the boardwalk to be built, to The Grove neighborhood and the rest of the surrounding community.

"This is a high-quality facility where you can bring in tournament from across the country in addition to the recreational needs that are here in our own community."

"The purpose of the new facility, officials said, is to accommodate the Florence Soccer Association and the city's growing youth soccer program. The venue will also to provide an attractive space for soccer tournaments and possibly lacrosse in the future."
